- To ensure that the environmental impacts of our venture operations have been properly assessed and demonstrate suitable and sufficient environmental management in line with best industry practise.
- To take a proactive approach to our social responsibility, mitigate our impact on our planet's environment and responding to climate change.
- To set clear HSE targets, to measure these and openly report on HSE performance.
- To actively engage with the communities where we have operational interests.
- To require our contractors to manage in line with this policy.
- To support and encourage our venture partners to manage HSE to a comparable level and we will actively participate in HSE governance and audit activities over venture operations.
- To ensure all significant incidents are fully investigated to root cause, positive improvement measures are taken to prevent recurrence and key learnings are shared.
